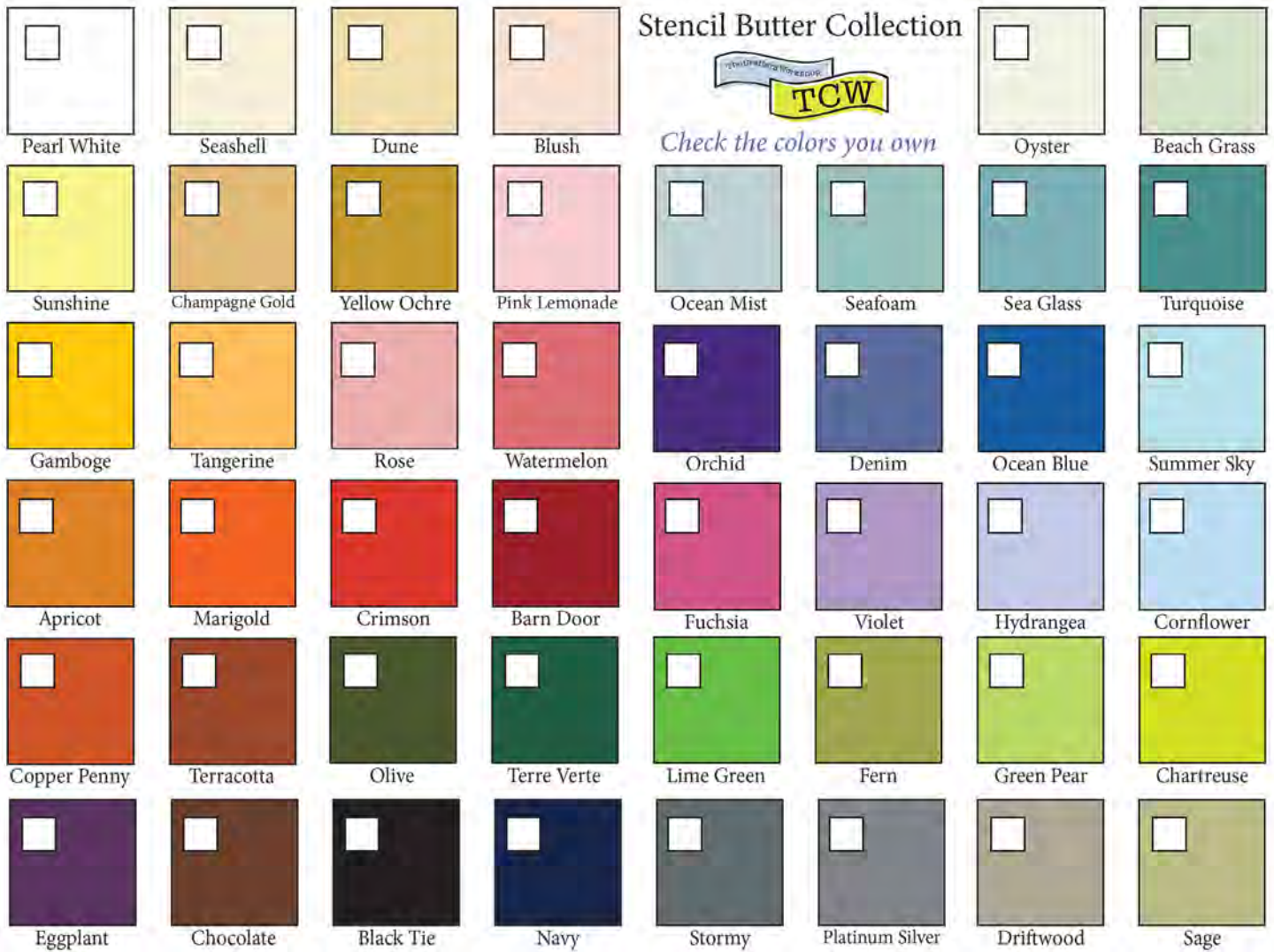

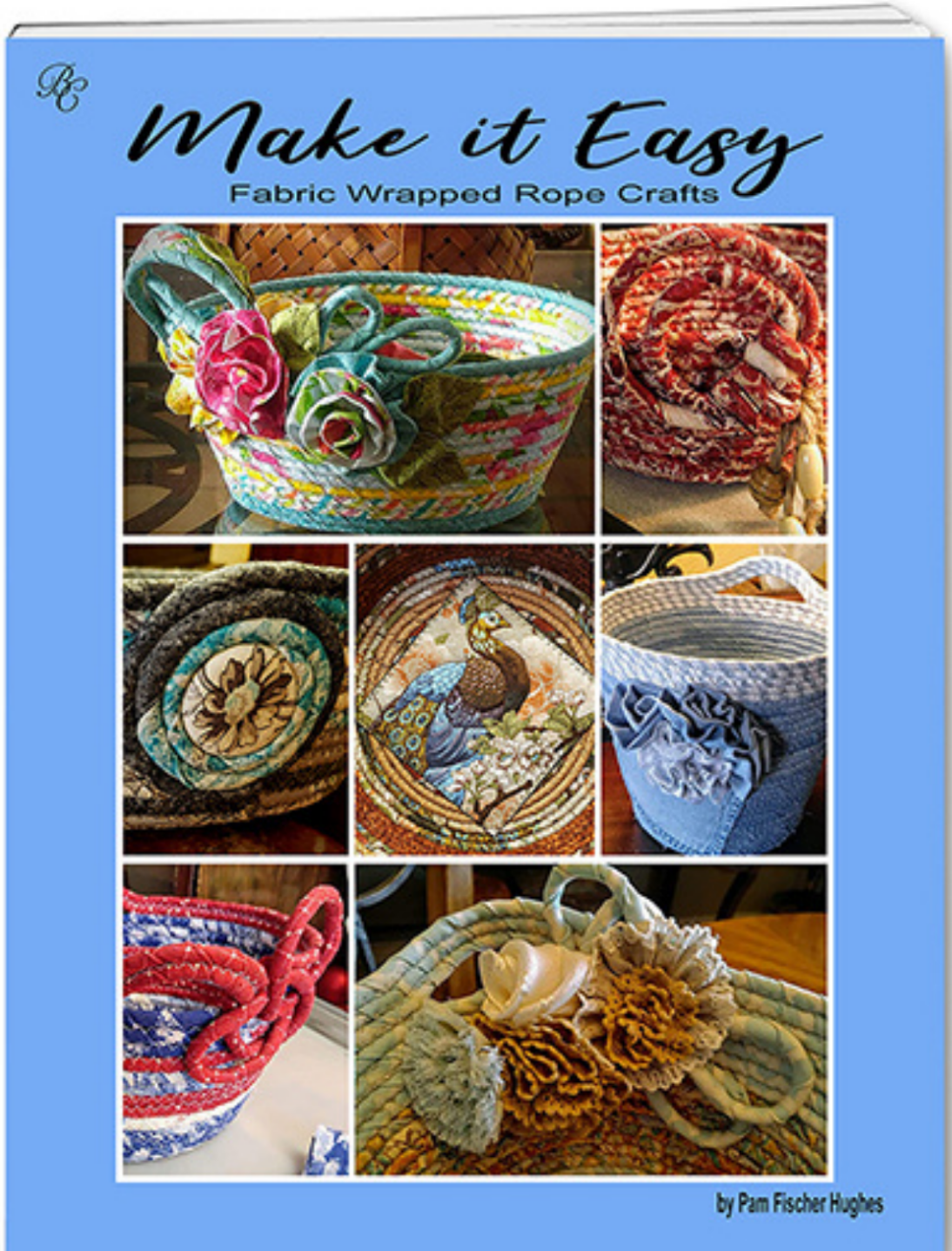

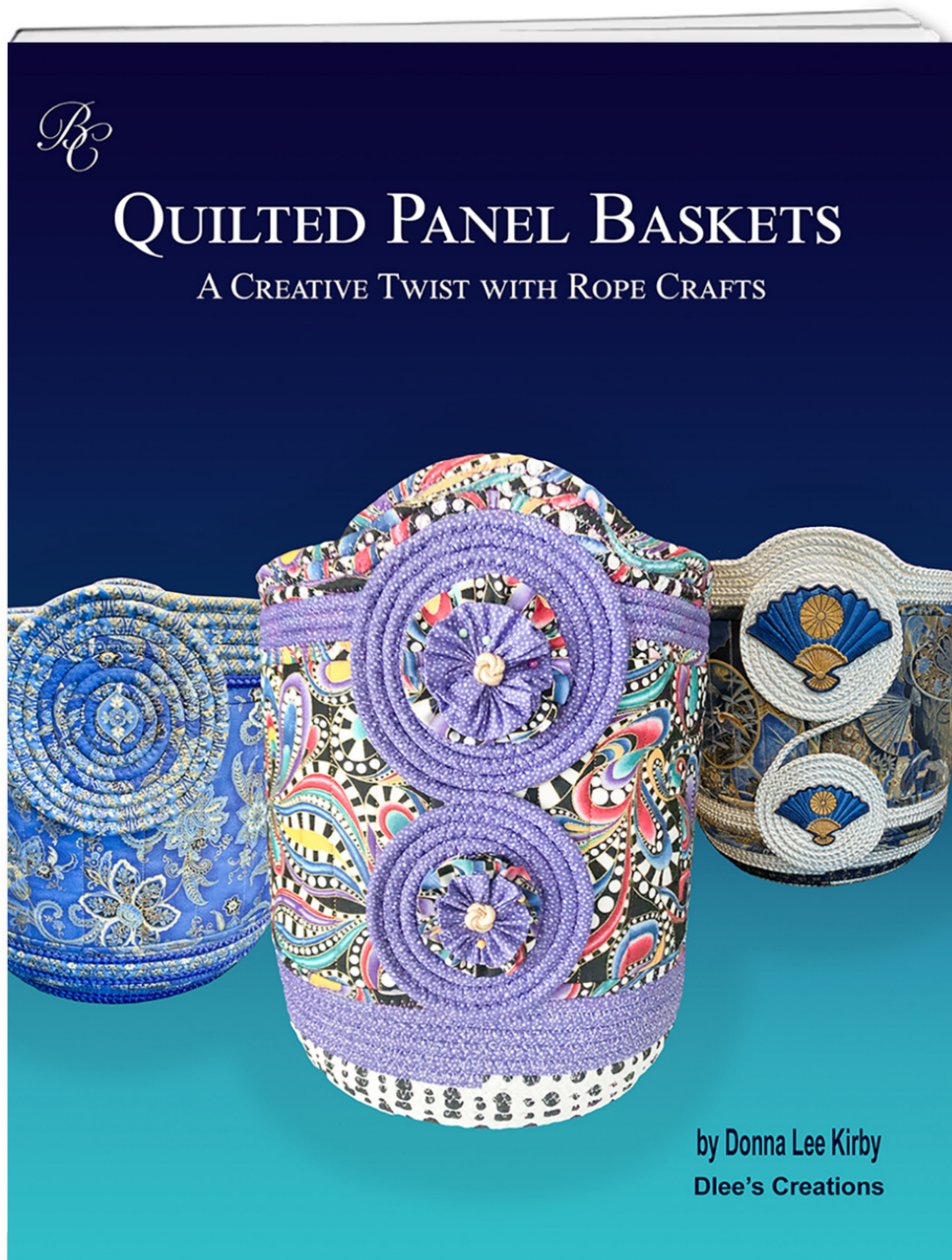

Fall Pillow Wrap

Whether you're decorating for the changing seasons or getting ready for a special holiday, pillow wraps make it simple and fun! Create a variety of custom looks by adding felt shapes to bands of fabric, then wrap them around your favorite pillows. When it's time to re-decorate, just switch the wrap for a fresh new design. Adding a cozy, decorative touch to your home has never been easier!

Instructions:

1. Unfold the drop cloth, then cut a piece about 15" wide and long enough to wrap around the center of the pillow, plus 4" to overlap at the back. Press to remove any wrinkles, then fold and press under about 1½" along each edge.
2. Upload the pumpkin and leaf patterns to Cricut Design Space.
3. Size each design to fit within a 4" square, then cut 2 pumpkins from Pumpkin Spice felt and 2 leaves from Orange felt using the "Felt, Acrylic" setting in the materials list with "More" pressure.
4. Carefully remove the cut pieces from the mat and set aside.
5. Cut two 4"x4" squares from Cashmere Tan felt and two 4"x4" squares from Walnut Corduroy felt.
6. Using 3 strands of dark brown embroidery floss and a simple running stitch, sew the pumpkin shapes to the Cashmere Tan squares and the leaves to the Walnut Corduroy squares. Replace the pumpkin stems with small pieces of Brown felt. Add a bow to the base of each stem with Green floss.
7. Wrap the band around the pillow, then position the squares on the front. Mark placement with pins. Remove the band from the pillow, then stitch the squares in place on the front of the band.
8. Stitch a button to the center of the 4 squares with Green floss.

- ◆ [Kunin® Classic Felt](#): Orange, Pumpkin Spice, 9" x 12"
- ◆ [Pumpkin Pattern](#)
- ◆ [Leaf Pattern](#)
- ◆ Fabric Mat, Pink
- ◆ Embroidery Floss: Dark Brown, Light Tan, Sage Green
- ◆ Button, 5/8"
- ◆ Pillow with a plain cover in a neutral color
- ◆ Cricut® Maker™ with Rotary Blade, optional*
- ◆ Canvas Drop Cloth
- ◆ Embroidery Needle
- ◆ Scissors

Stenciled Fall Pillow

Add a handmade touch to your autumn décor with a cozy stenciled pillow! Whether you use the included free download with freezer paper or choose iron-on vinyl, this project comes together quickly and beautifully. Perfect for welcoming guests and bringing a warm seasonal feel to your home.

Instructions:

1. Cut the tag from the inside of the pillow cover and press the cover with an iron to remove wrinkles.
2. Download the free design and size it as desired in Cricut Design Space (or the program for your electronic cutting machine). Cut the design from freezer paper.
3. Iron the words “Welcome” and “HME” (for Home) onto the pillow cover, leaving space for the pumpkin and “to our.” Place a piece of cardboard inside the pillow cover to prevent ink bleed-through.
4. Using a stencil brush and Black ink, fill in “Welcome” and the “HME”. Remove the freezer paper and heat set with an iron.
5. Next, iron “to our” and the pumpkin design onto the pillow cover. Stencil “to our” with Black ink. Use Orange and Green inks to fill in the pumpkin design. Remove the freezer paper and heat set.
6. If any ink bleeds outside the design, stencil additional pumpkin leaves over the area with green ink, then heat set.
7. Fill the pillow cover with Poly-fil, starting with the corners and continuing until full but not tightly packed. This will keep the pillow light and fluffy. Zip the cover closed.

Fancy Foam Pumpkins

You know those smooth little foam pumpkins from the dollar store? Cute, but kinda...boring, right? Well, grab your glue gun, because we're about to give them a total glow-up! With a lotta hot glue dots, you can transform those plain pumpkins into knucklehead bumpy pumpkins that look like they came straight out of a quirky farm stand. It's cheap, it's easy, and it's seriously fun...the kind of project that makes you say, "why didn't I think of this sooner?" From foam to fancy in minutes...let's get dotting!

Instructions:

1. Fully charge your glue gun and have plenty of glue sticks on hand.
2. Press tip of glue gun onto surface of pumpkin and gently pull trigger. Begin by applying glue dots around top of pumpkin to feel the flow of the glue. Hint, the smaller the dot, the more it will hold its circle shape.
3. Larger glue dots tend to run so try placing a fan on your tabletop to quickly cool the glue dots. Also, if you tip the pumpkin quickly back and forth, that helps to hold the circle shapes until the glue starts to cool. If one dot (or 10!) get drippy, no problem! Let it cool and add smaller dots on top.
4. Once you have applied your first dots over the pumpkin, now you want to go back and fill in with smaller glue dots in between until you have covered the entire foam surface.
5. Don't worry about the glue strings because you can fix those strings with a heat gun.
6. Set your heat gun to lowest setting and keep moving it above the surface of the glue. Check and double check to be sure you have heated all the glue strings until they disappear. Again, remember to keep your heat gun moving around at all times.
7. To add veins to your burlap leaves, just draw the lines with your glue gun.
8. To finish your pumpkins and leaves, spray paint in the color and finish of your choice. Let dry.

Grateful Tag Card

Capture the warmth of autumn and the spirit of gratitude with a handmade card full of layered textures and heartfelt details. It's the perfect way to share appreciation and celebrate the blessings of the season.

Instructions:

1. Stamp the images onto White cardstock using a Black inkpad. Color the images with watercolor pencils. Lightly spray with a clear sealer, then cut them out.
2. Die cut the slotted die from patterned paper. Then, die cut the smaller die three times with different patterned papers. Cut a piece of Green cardstock 11³/₄"x5¹/₄" and fold it with the fold at the top of the card. Add double-sided tape to the sides and bottom of the slotted paper and adhere it to the Green cardstock. Adhere the three layers of patterned paper to the slotted card. (See project photo for placement.)
3. For the tags, die cut three pieces of White cardstock and three pieces of patterned paper. Adhere them together to make three tags. Create another tag shape slightly larger, cut three pieces from Orange cardstock, and adhere these to the backs of the tags.
4. To decorate the tags, cut three pieces each of burlap lace trim, heart fabric trim, and Brown ribbon. Adhere the burlap trim and heart trim to the tags. Fold the ribbon into a "V" shape and attach it to the tags. Adhere the stamped images, then add the metal embellishments.
5. Once the tags are decorated, slide them into the slots of the card base. Keep embellishments fairly flat so they will fit into the slots.

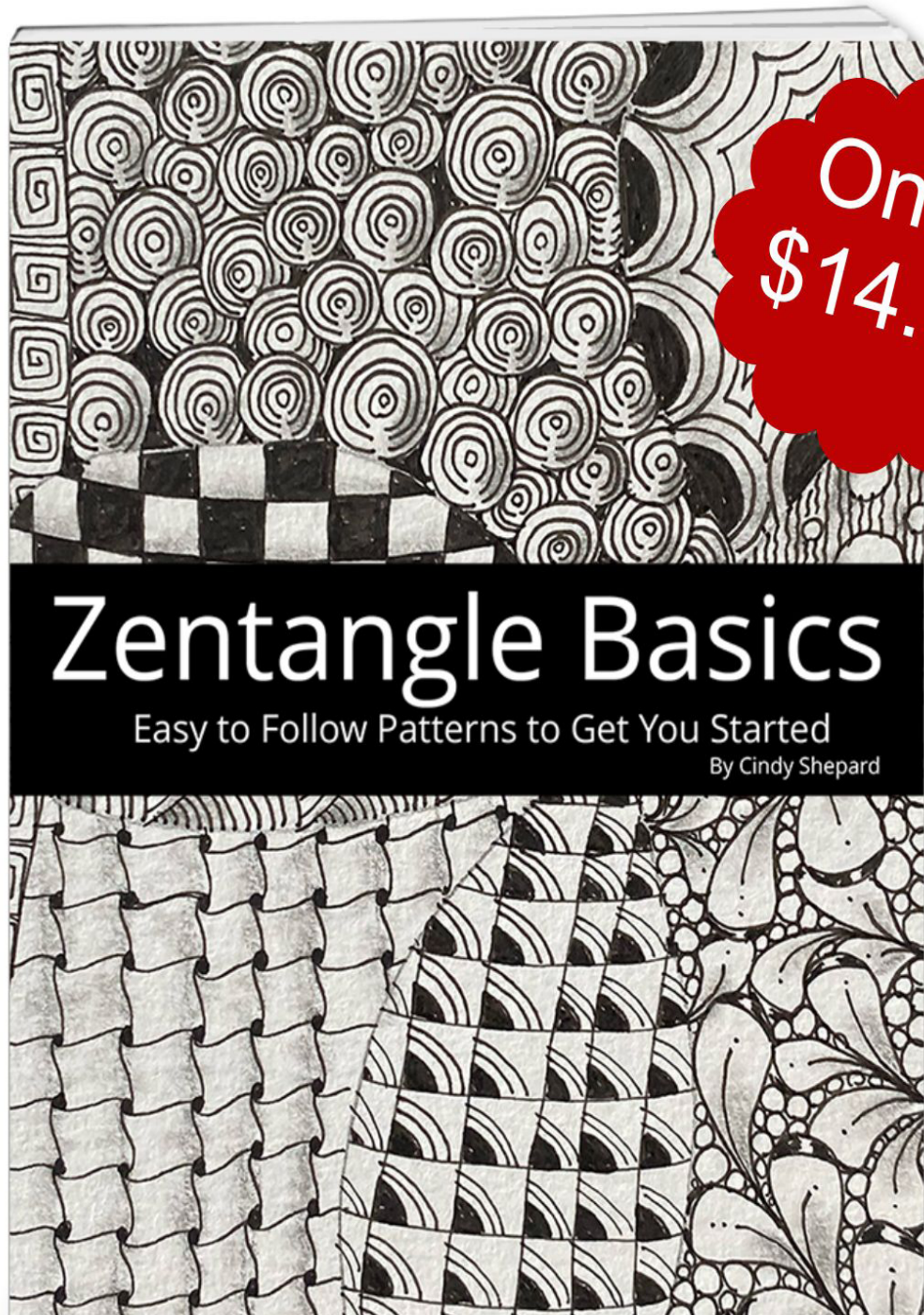

Add a playful twist to your Halloween crafting with bold colors, spooky details, and a hidden pocket inside - the perfect spot to tuck a gift card or little cash surprise. It's a fun and unexpected treat your friends and family will love!!

Materials

- ◆ Cardstock: Black, Orange, White, Green
- ◆ Glitter Paper: Orange, Purple
- ◆ Newton's Nook Designs Halloween Patterned Papers
- ◆ [Royal Talens Watercolor Pencils](#)
- ◆ [Gina K. Designs Inkpads](#): Obsidian, Sweet Mango, Wild Lilac
- ◆ Bat Brad
- ◆ Glitter Dots
- ◆ [Foam Tape](#)
- ◆ Zip Dry Paper Glue

Tools

- ◆ Newton's Nook Designs Stamp Sets: Brooms & Boos, Spiderweb Oval
- ◆ Newton's Nook Designs Dies: Brooms & Boos, Spiderweb Oval, Oval Frames
- ◆ Paintbrush
- ◆ Paper Trimmer
- ◆ [Big Shot](#)

Instructions:

1. Cut the Papers:
 - Black cardstock – 4½"x11"; score at 2¾" and 5½"
 - Orange cardstock – 4¼"x10½"; score at 5¼"
 - White cardstock – 4"x5" (cut 2)
 - Green cardstock – 4¼"x2½" (cut 2)
 - Purple patterned paper – 4"x5"
 - Candy patterned paper – 3½"x4"
 - Skull & bats patterned papers – 4¼"x2¼"
2. Stamp the spider web with Black onto the White cardstock pieces. Using blending brushes, add shading with Orange and Purple inks around the webs. On a scrap piece of White cardstock, stamp three witches and two bats. Color with watercolors, then die cut with the matching dies.
3. Die Cut Shapes:
 - Orange and Purple glitter papers with the large scalloped oval die.
 - Green cardstock with the large oval.
 - White cardstock with the medium oval, (2).
 - White cardstock with the small oval.
4. To create the gift card notch, position the small oval die halfway onto a piece of patterned paper and cut.

5. Fold the Orange cardstock along the score line. Adhere one White panel to the front. Stamp "EEK!" and the spider as shown. Add the Orange glitter scalloped oval around the spider web. Attach one witch and two bats with foam tape.
6. Stamp word images on the small and medium White ovals. Adhere the Purple striped and Candy patterned papers to the top inside panel. Attach the second White panel to the bottom. Place the Purple glitter oval around the spider web. Add the two witches and stamped word ovals with foam tape.
7. Open the Black cardstock and adhere the Orange card to the top section. Layer the patterned papers onto the Green cardstock. Adhere this piece between the score marks on the Black card. Stamp the sentiment on the small White oval, then layer it onto the Green oval. Attach the Purple bat to the layered ovals and secure to the bottom of the card with foam tape.
8. Add glitter dots to the card front and inside panels for extra sparkle. Refer to the project photos for placement.

Halloween Treat Card

A handmade Halloween card is the perfect way to give your treats a little extra magic. Instead of just handing out candy, surprise your trick-or-treaters with a card that has a hidden pocket for sweets. It's a fun twist that makes every piece of candy feel even more special!

Instructions:

1. Lay a piece of Deco Foil, pretty side up, on top of the patterned toner paper. Place the foil and paper inside parchment paper and run it through the laminator. Remove and peel the foil away.
2. Repeat with a piece of Black toner paper., using the foil from the patterned toner paper.
3. Cut the Papers as follows:
 - Black cardstock – 11"x7"
 - Orange cardstock – 1³/₈"x4⁷/₈" and 2⁷/₈"x4⁷/₈"
 - Foiled papers – 1¹/₄"x4³/₄" and 2³/₄"x4³/₄"
 - White cardstock (tag) – 2¹/₄"x4"
 - Orange cardstock (tag) – 2¹/₄"x4"
4. Die cut two ovals from from scrap pieces of Orange and White cardstock. Die cut one tag from White cardstock.
5. Starting from the right side, score the long side of the Black cardstock at: 3", 6", 7¹/₂", 8¹/₄", 9³/₄", and 10¹/₂". Score the shorter piece at 1/2", 1/4", and 6¹/₄".
6. Use the diagram to determine which areas to cut and score. Fold the cardstock along the score lines. Assemble and adhere the box portion of the card. Fold the right side of the cardstock and adhere the bottom and side to form the tag pocket.
7. Cut a diagonal from the Orange cardstock and Green foiled paper, then cut each piece 1/8" smaller to layer the tag pocket.
8. Stamp the images on White cardstock with ink. Color with watercolor pencils and cut them out.
9. To finish the card, layer and adhere the foiled papers to the Black cardstock. Stamp the sentiments on the White ovals and adhere them to the Orange ovals. Attach the stamped images to the card. Cut the Orange cardstock into a tag shape and adhere it to the White tag. Adhere ribbons to the tag. Fill the box with candy to complete the card.

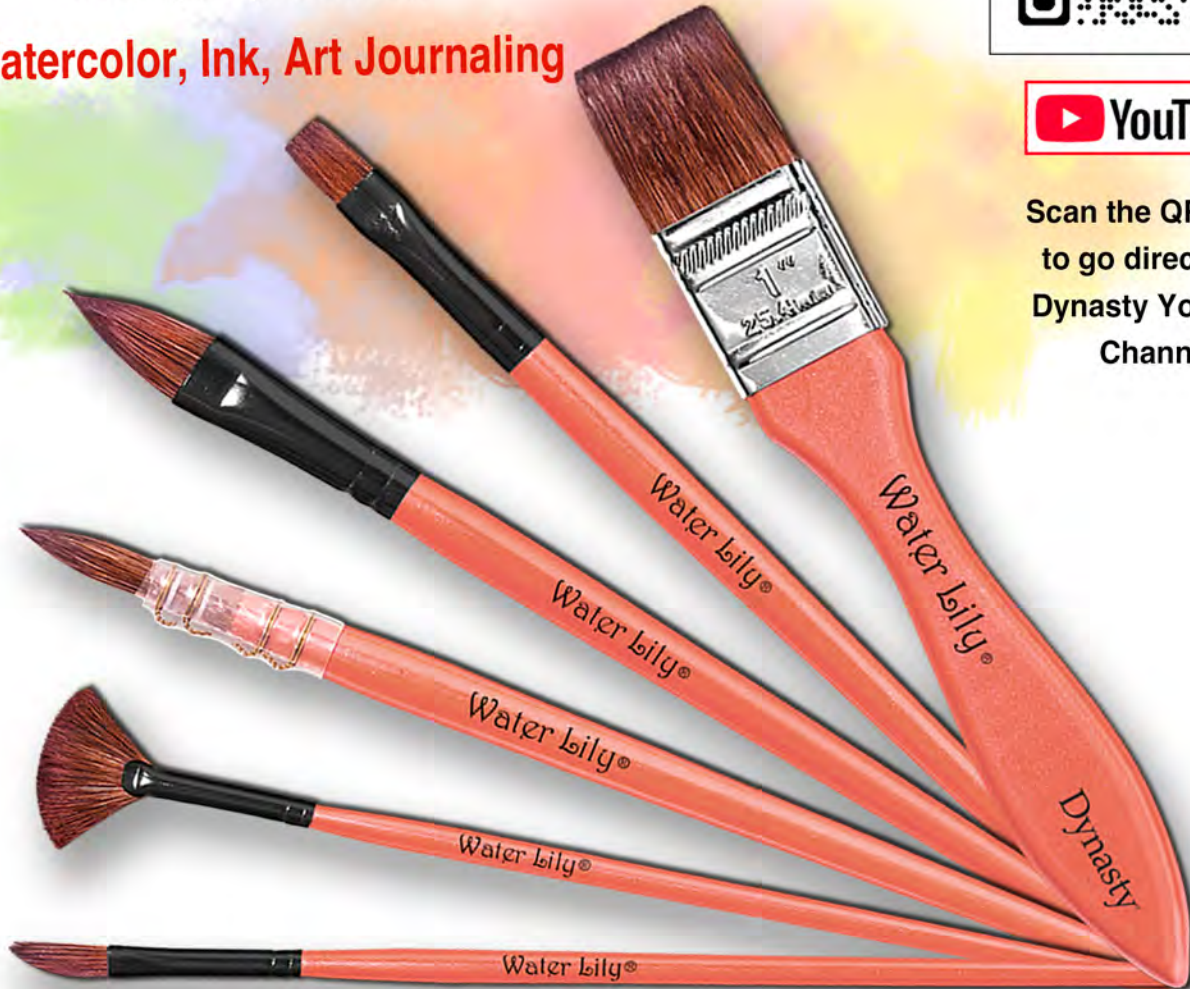

How to make it:

Step 1: Open the cut file in your cutter's software. If needed, resize each design to fit your shirts.

Tip: This design is available for free in Leonardo® Design Studio!

Step 2: Mirror the designs, then separate the different layers.

Step 3: Load EasyWeed Black into your cutter and send the first jack o' lantern face to be cut. When the cut has finished, remove EasyWeed Black from your cutter.

Tip: No cutter? No problem! You can also use scissors to cut these shapes out by hand.

Step 4: Load EasyWeed White into your cutter next and send the second jack o' lantern face to be cut. When the cut has finished, remove EasyWeed White from your cutter.

Step 5: Load EasyWeed Orange into your cutter next and send the third jack o' lantern face to be cut. When the cut has finished, remove EasyWeed Orange from your cutter.

Step 6: Use an EasyWeeder to remove the excess material and cavities from all 3 sheets of HTV.

Step 7: Set your heat press to 305°F / 150°C. If using a home iron, set it to the "Cotton" or "Linen" setting with the steam function turned OFF.

Step 8: Place the first shirt on the heat press platen or a flat, hard surface and pre-press the application area for a few seconds to remove any wrinkles or moisture.

Step 9: Arrange the first jack o' lantern face of your choice onto the shirt as desired and place a cover sheet on top. Press for 15 seconds, then peel the carrier hot.

Step 10: Repeat steps 8 and 9 for the second and third shirts with the remaining jack o' lantern faces. You now have a group outfit fit for spooky season!

Rustic Sunflower Can Do-over

Save your cans and turn them into some pretty floral decorations to use indoors or outdoors. Either way they'll add a nice addition to your home.

Instructions:

1. Remove the paper from the cans and rinse thoroughly. Save the tabs from the tops of the cans.
2. If you want a tight bunch of flowers in your vase, place an empty water bottle inside the can and insert the flower stems into the neck to hold them together. Mini water bottles can be used as is. For larger bottles, cut them in half so the top sits about $\frac{1}{2}$ " below the top of the can. Flowers can also be held in place by filling the can with shredded paper.
3. Cut a piece of Brown paper to fit around the can. Overlap the ends and secure with adhesive. Option: Add a border of corrugated Brown paper around the top and bottom edges of the can. The ribbon will cover the center section.
4. Cut a piece of ribbon long enough to wrap around the can, plus $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Secure the overlapped end with adhesive. Wrap jute around the center and tie at the front in a bow or simple overhand knot, depending on the look you want.

Fall Wood Pumpkins

Bring the beauty of fall indoors with rustic wood pumpkins! Painted in layers of warm colors, topped with decoupaged napkins, and finished with natural accents, they're the perfect handmade touch for your autumn décor.

Instructions:

1. Mix together a small amount of orange, yellow, and red acrylic paint to create a warm, blended base. Use black paint sparingly. Paint each wood block. Let dry completely.
2. Separate the napkin so that only the top printed layer remains. Apply a thin coat of Mod Podge to the front of a block and carefully place the napkin on top, smoothing it gently to avoid wrinkles. Sand the edges to remove the excess napkin. Once dry, seal with another coat of Mod Podge. Let dry.
3. Sand the edges of the wood blocks leaving a bit of the natural wood showing through.
4. Adhere a small piece of tree branch to the top of each block to make a stem.
5. Tie raffia around the stems for a rustic touch.
6. Add veins to the leaves with glue and apply glitter.
7. Add silk leaves and wired berries around the stem.
8. Make a bow with fabric strips and add to the top, if desired.

Materials

- ◆ [Them O Web Fancy Foils](#): Grass Green, Sweet Mango, Wild Dandelion

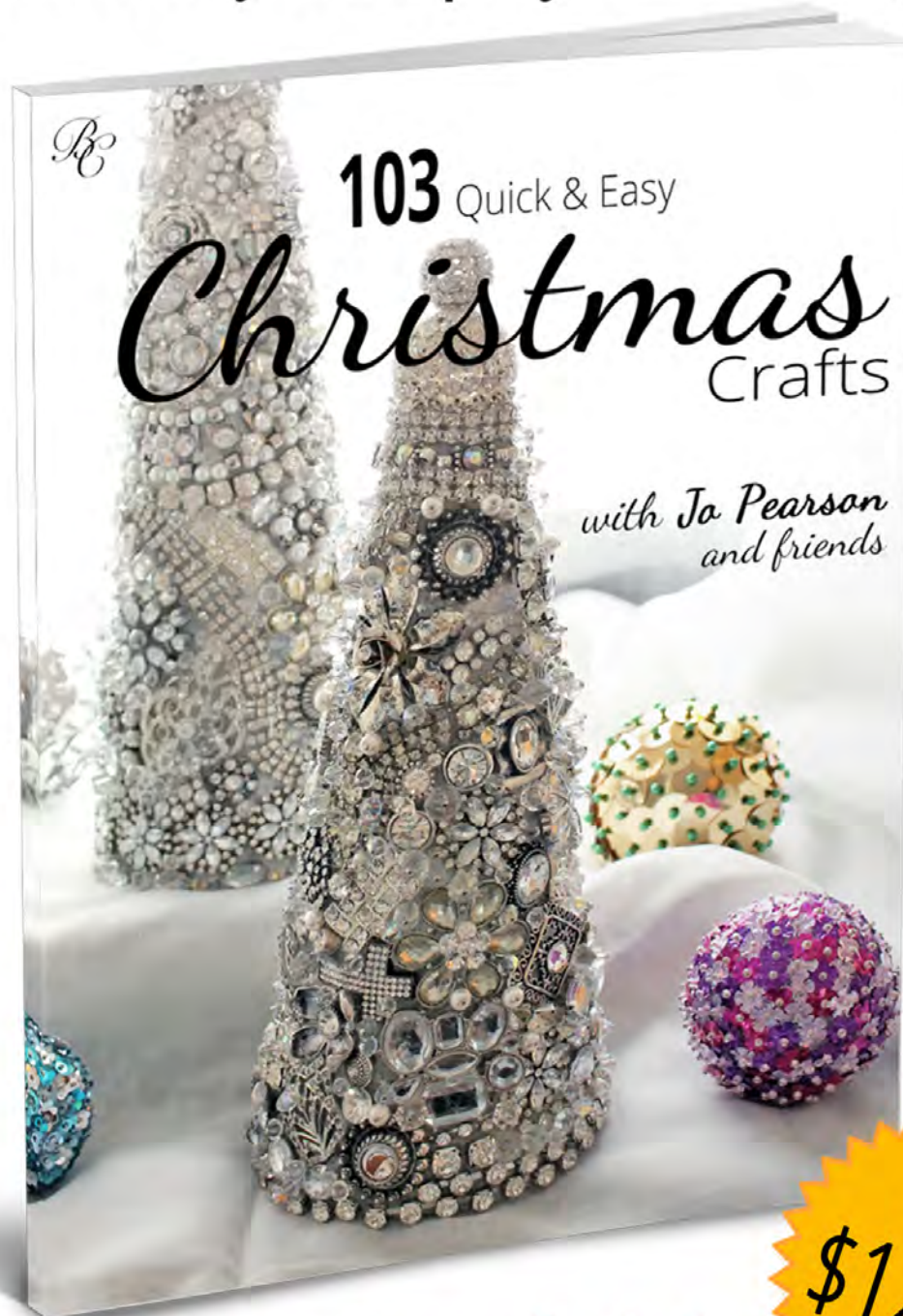
Instructions:

1. Spray Pixie Spray on the back of the stencil, then position it on the canister. Using a palette knife, apply a layer of Transfer Gel Duo over the stencil, scrape away the excess, and return it to the jar. Allow the gel to dry until it turns clear.
2. Place Deco Foil shiny side up over the dried Transfer Gel and rub with your

3. fingers to cover the entire design. Peel back the foil to reveal the transfer. If any areas are missing, simply lay the foil down again and rub until the design is fully covered.
3. Cut a piece of adhesive sheet slightly larger than the tree die, cover it with foil, die cut it to create the foiled tree.
4. To create the leaves, place the stencil on a piece of cardstock and apply Transfer Gel Duo as before. Once dry, cover with foil, sandwich inside parchment paper with a cardstock shim, and run it through the laminator. Die cut the leaves and adhere them to the foiled tree.
5. Cut a piece of vintage patterned paper to 3½"x3¾". Distress the edges, then blend ink around them with a brush for added depth. Stamp "Autumn Wishes" with a Black inkpad on tan cardstock, cut it out, and layer it onto kraft and green cardstock. Stamp and die cut a small leaf with Green ink on Tan cardstock, then adhere the layered sentiment and leaf to the front of the canister.
6. To finish the project, adhere a second piece of vintage patterned paper to the top of the canister lid. Once it is covered, attach the mini hay bale, rake, flowerpot, and pumpkin stickers, arranging them into a festive fall display. Finally, wrap corrugated paper around the outside edge of the lid and secure it in place for a rustic finishing touch.

Embrace the cozy charm of autumn! Capture the essence of fall with layered textures, warm colors, and the promise of quiet, thoughtful moments spent curled up with your favorite book.

Instructions:

1. Cut the Papers as follows:
 - Burgundy cardstock – 10"x6", folded in half
 - Orange cardstock – 9"x5½"
 - Patterned papers: Plaid 4⁷/₈"x5⁷/₈", Leaves 4³/₈"x5³/₈", Checkered 2¹/₈"x5³/₈" (cut 2)
2. Fold the Orange cardstock in half. From the right side, score at 2¼" and again at 4½". Adhere the patterned papers to each section. Measure 3" down from the top right side and cut a diagonal line as shown.
3. Die cut two pieces of White cardstock and one piece of patterned paper with the bookmark die. Die cut a large scalloped label from Tan cardstock. Layer both oval dies and cut from Burgundy cardstock. Adhere the pieces together.
4. Stamp the image of the books and pumpkins onto White cardstock. Color with watercolor pencils and cut out. Stamp the sentiments as shown.
5. Adhere the images to the bookmark. Cut fibers 10" long and tie them to the top. Attach two miniature books to the ends of the fibers. Sandwich a couple of fibers between two sunflower buttons and adhere together.
6. Add lace and buttons to the card base as shown. Apply double-sided tape along the right side and bottom to create a pocket. Place the finished bookmark inside.
